In practice, coverage boundaries are highly complex with some regions of good and poor reception both inside and outside the coverage areas shown. Satisfactory reception is possible at favoured locations outside the shown coverage areas and conversely, there will be isolated pockets of poor coverage inside the areas shown.

Engineering enhancements at the receiving points (eg. high gain receiving antennas, masthead amplifiers, etc) can also greatly expand the area of satisfactory reception.
