



Terenga 6: Hōtaka 53 - Ngā pū 'mō' me 'ki'

He Mihi

Tauti mai, rarau mai ki roto ki ngā ringa whakahiapo o Ako, te toro atu nei ki a koutou, i ō koutou kāinga, wāhi mahi, kura, i hea ake rānei. Huihuia mai ō tātou manako kia piki te reo i roto i a tātou ki ōna keokeonga o Tika, o Rere, o Māori.

Hei Mahi Whakarongo

- 3) E kōrero ana ia mō ēhea moana?

Kia whakarongo ake tātou ki tēnei kaituhi, kaiako, kaiwhakataki, kaihāpai i te reo, kaiwhakatipu toa reo Māori anō hoki.

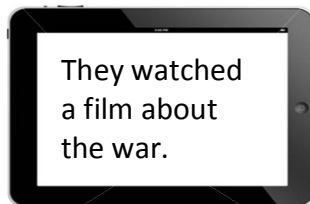
He Whakamārama

E whai ake nei ētehi huarahi e rua i te reo Māori hei whakaputa i te whakaaro 'about' o te reo Pākehā. Tēnā tirohia ēnei rerenga e rua:

- a) E kōrero ana ia mō te ture. *She's talking about the law.*
- e) E kōrero ana ia ki te ture. *She's talking about the law.*

E whai wāhi ai te pū 'ki' ki tēnei whakatakotoranga, me noho tētehi tūmahi e hāngai ana ki te 'kōrero' ki te rerenga.

Mahi ĩpapa: *I mātakina e rātou tētahi kiriata mō te pakanga.*

Hei Mahi:

1. E kōrero ana koe mō/ki te aha?
2. Kei te tuhi au mō taku tupuna koroua.
3. Kei te hiahia au ki te whakapuaki whakaaro mō/ki tērā take.
4. Kua rongu koe mō Hoani?
